- ➔ Airport: From the station Wien-Mitte/Landstrasse take the underground U4 (direction Hütteldorf) to Karlsplatz.
- ➔ Train: From the station Südtiroler Platz-Hauptbahnhof take the underground U1 (direction Leopoldau) to Taubstummengasse





Floor plan

Enter the building through the main entrance (glass door) and continue straight on the ground floor, circumventing the guard's box on either side. There are a few steps down and you will arrive at the aula with the registration desk and the main lecture hall.

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Arrival in Vienna

By Airplane

The Vienna International Airport (VIE) in Wien-Schwechat is situated about 20 km south-east of Vienna. On the <https://www.viennaairportlines.at/en/> you find flight information as well as transportations into the city center:

- **ÖBB-Train Railjet to station Wien Hauptbahnhof** (central station) (takes 15 to 18 minutes).
Departure from the airport about every 30 minutes. Tickets available at vending machines directly at the station (4.50 Euros) are valid for connections in Vienna as well (urban railways, underground, tram and bus).
- **Local Train: S-Bahn to station Wien-Mitte/Landstrasse** (takes 24 minutes).
The Local Trains “S-Bahn S7” to Wien-Mitte/Landstraße depart every 30 minutes from the airport. Tickets available at vending machines directly at the station (4.50 Euros) and are valid for connections in Vienna as well (urban railways, underground, tram and bus). From there take the underground U4 to Karlsplatz, then walk to the venue, passing St. Charles's church.
- **City Airport Train** (<https://www.cityairporttrain.com/en/>) **to terminal station Wien-Mitte/** (takes 16 minutes).
Departure from the airport every 30 minutes (single ticket 14,90 Euros). From there take the underground U4 to „Karlsplatz“ (extra ticket required, 2.40 Euros).
- **Taxi** from the airport to the conference venue (about 45 Euros)
- **Vienna Airport Lines Bus Service** to
 - Wien Hauptbahnhof: every 30 minutes; Travel time 25 minutes
 - Wien Schwedenplatz: every 30 minutes; Travel time 20 minutes

By Train

If you prefer travelling by train you will find all the necessary information at the Austrian Federal Railways website (<https://www.oebb.at/en/>) or via phone +43-5-1717.

How to reach the venue from railway stations:

- from Wien Hauptbahnhof (central station): Underground U1 (direction „Leopoldau“) to „Taubstummengasse“
- from Wien Regionalbahnhof (terminal railway station Wien West): Underground U3 (direction “Simmering”) to “Stephansplatz”, change there to underground U1 (direction “Alaudagasse”/“Oberlaa“) to “Taubstummengasse”
- from Franz-Josefs-Bahnhof (terminal railway station North-West): Tram line D (direction „Absberggasse“) to stop „Gußhausstrasse“
- from Wien-Nord / Praterstern (railway station North): Underground U1 (direction „Alaudagasse”/“Oberlaa” to „Taubstummengasse“

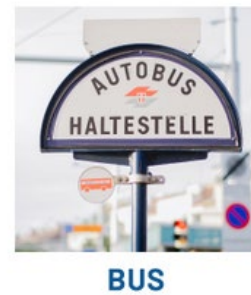

Public Transport in Vienna

Some basic facts about public transportation:

Luckily, all means of public transportation within the city limits can be used with the same ticket:

- **Underground (“U-Bahn”)**
- **Urban Railways (“S-Bahn”)**
- **Tramway**
- **Bus**



Even a single ticket allows (multiple) connections, but no return trips.

Where do I get a ticket?

Various types of tickets are sold at tobacconists (“Trafik”), at vending machines in underground and S-Bahn stations and in some hotels. Even though there are also other options, it is highly recommended that you buy the ticket before you enter the means of transportation.

Get from A to B quickly with the official Wiener Linien app! ([WienMobil App](#))

There are several types of tickets:

- Single ticket (2.40 Euros)
- flexible 7-day Vienna ticket: (19.70 Euros)
- Various tickets: valid for a day or more
- Half-price tickets: are required for children (aged 6-15) and dogs
